

HTOCA ANNUAL MEETING

MSNV Resolution

Whereas, the Montessori School of Northern Virginia (MSNV) located in the Hillbrook Tall Oaks community, has expressed plans to expand its student population by adding grades 4, 5 and 6 to the enrolled student population of the school;

Whereas, the planned MSNV expansion will increase the student population from the current 135 to approximately 235 students, a significant increase in population;

Whereas, the MSNV planned expansion will require a physical expansion of buildings, parking area and playground area to accommodate the additional student population;

Whereas, the proposed MSNV expansion will result in a significant increase in the number of vehicles traveling through the HTOCA neighborhood thereby posing significant traffic and safety problems;

Whereas, the impact of the MSNV expansion will have an impact on the entire HTOCA community and is therefore a significantly important issue to be considered by the HTOCA Board of Directors;

Whereas, the HTOCA Board is charged with the current bylaws to protect the interests of the HTOCA community;

Therefore, Be It Resolved at the HTOCA Annual Meeting on June 25, 2006 that:

The Membership of HTOCA hereby directs the HTOCA Board to make the MSNV issue its top priority for the upcoming fiscal year, to conduct a survey of Hillbrook TallOaks residents to determine if the Association should go on record opposing any and all MSNV expansion. The HTOCA Board shall report their recommendations to the entire HTOCA community no later than September 30, 2006.
